What is the purpose of an Annual Wellness Visit?

This visit will assist patients in developing a more personalized plan to prevent disease and to improve their health and overall quality of care. It's an extended visit with a Registered Nurse that serves as an opportunity to share a more in-depth and holistic view of their health.

Does this replace an annual PCP physical?

No, this is an additional opportunity to be seen and discuss health concerns and issues. The information will be shared with the Primary Care Provider and carefully considered in developing a plan of care.

Emily's Story

Breast Cancer diagnosis won't stop this South County mom

When **Emily Monto** received a follow-up call for additional imaging after her annual mammogram at South County Health Medical and Wellness Center in Westerly this July, she had no idea she would be one of the one in eight women who will be diagnosed with breast cancer during her lifetime.



"My son was six when I was diagnosed, he's seven now. It's so hard to believe it can happen. It's hard to believe it can happen to you. I know mammograms can be uncomfortable, and getting biopsied was not a pleasant experience," says Emily, "But regular screening is critical. More than that, it is lifesaving."

Emily, an Occupational Therapist Assistant and medical coder in her early 40's, and a longtime patient of Steven Schneider, MD, at South County Health Center for Women's Health, was busy enjoying the Rhode Island summer, her young son, and a much-needed vacation when she received that call.

Crucially, Emily did not delay the next step of her care. She came back to South County Health for a diagnostic mammogram to help determine if signs or symptoms are indicative of the presence of cancer. They were.

Emily underwent a biopsy to capture tissue for sampling. During that time a small clip was placed in the breast at the site of the lesion. This was used later as guidance by Emily's General Surgeon, Gracie Luetters, MD.

"My experience at South County Hospital was great," Emily said. "The day I came in for my surgery, it was so sweet, one of the volunteers even held my hand as they walked me to my appointment. Dr. Luetters was very good. She was concerned about what I'd been through already, and she really cared."

Emily underwent a successful lumpectomy in August and will begin treatment at South County Health Radiation Therapy in the coming weeks.

Emily is one of thousands of women nationwide who develop breast cancer each year. That number continues to rise at a startling rate, surpassing prostate cancer recently as the most common cancer diagnosed in Rhode Island, according to the American Cancer Society.

When breast cancer is detected early, in the localized stage, the 5-year survival rate is 99%. Clinical breast exams and mammograms, along with monthly self-exams, are key to early detection. 🍏



Seeking out Skill ... and Kindness

When **Jacob Goldenberg** needed to be treated for an inguinal hernia in early 2023, "the experience," he says, "from the very beginning, was very positive."

Next thing I knew, I was being wheeled to the OR and what seemed like moments later, I was being greeted by a nurse after my surgery. 


